Subject: 72 hour eviction notice

This letter is to state that your stay and welcome is terminated on the Akwesasne Mohawk Territory. You have 72 hours to comply. We can not guarantee your safety after the 72 hour notice (May 1, 2013). We the people have the right to make a judgement on your safety and the safety of the people because of the accusations and threats you have made against the people and the community. This includes the forging of documents using the Longhouse letter head which was used to make threats to the St. Regis Mohawk Tribe and the St. Regis Mohawk Police.

We also cannot guarantee your safety because you are not a member of the Longhouse and do not represent the Longhouse or any Mohawks in any court. You are not a Mohawk, nor are you from this reservation, you are just a visitor. We are also demanding the return of all Longhouse documents and the Longhouse letterhead. The Kanienkehaka Kaienere'kowa Kanonsesne has never supported you on any legal matters you are or may have been working on.

Any more letters coming from the Longhouse will have the Longhouse seal as shown. Showing that this is a real letter from the people.
